This new, state-of-the-art Preschool will provide fertile ground for planting the seeds of our tomorrow.

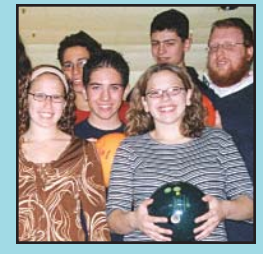
Chabad Hebrew School

The Mikvah has served as the foundation of Jewish family life since the day the Torah was given at Mt. Sinai. Our new premises will host the very first Mikvah to be built in Northwest NJ.
